The weed plan priorities are: Spurge, Spotted knapweed, Yellow Star Thistle, Burdock, Mullen, Houndstongue, Canadian Thistle.

WHY SHOULD I CARE?

Controlling noxious weeds is a Mt. state law. If you are a property owner, you are responsible.

Weeds choke out the native plant community.

Weeds also increase soil erosion, polluting our rivers.

Some weeds are toxic to wildlife and livestock.

Our weeds spill over into rangeland.

Noxious weeds make an undesirable habitat for animals and birds.

Weeds compromise recreational land value.

WHAT CAN I DO?

You can be a part of the solution by being aware. Otherwise you are part of the problem. We need to show good stewardship to the land we are enjoying.

If your ATV has been off road, clean it before bringing onto the property.
